SUBJECT: Substance Use Disorder Standard Licensure Survey Findings for Serenity Point Recovery – Follow-up Survey

Dear Mr. Hallmark:

A follow-up standard licensure inspection was conducted on August 29, 2017 at Serenity Point Recovery pursuant to Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Part 62, Section 333.6238, which obligates the department to make at least one visit to each licensed health facility or agency every three years for survey and evaluation for the purpose of licensure. The August 29, 2017 inspection was preceded by a state licensure inspection on May 10, 2017 that identified that Serenity Point Recovery was not in substantial compliance on multiple items required for licensure. These identified issues included 325.14925 Physician Review and 325.14102 Patient Care, 325.14101(h) detoxification treatment.
