SUBJECT: State Licensure Survey Findings for A Forever Recovery

Dear Ms. Anderson:

A state licensure survey was conducted on August 12, 2021 at A Forever Recovery (SA0130102), pursuant to Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Part 62, Section 333.6238, which obligates the department to make at least one visit to each licensed health facility or agency every three years for survey and evaluation for the purpose of licensure.

During the state licensure survey, it was observed that the facility located at 216 St. Mary's Lake Road, Battle Creek, MI 49017, appears to have been abandoned. There were no employees or patients at this facility. There were past due notices from the utility company posted on the door. The Department has attempted to contact the program and the Executive Director on numerous occasions, in which no one from the program has returned phone calls to the Department. A Forever Recovery is found to be in violation of R 325.1341 which requires the licensee to notify the Department in writing 30 days prior to closure.

In addition, in accordance with R 325.1305, a license must be renewed before August 1st of each calendar year and if the license is not renewed within 30 days after the expiration date, the department may take licensure action. As the license was not renewed before August 1st of 2021, the expiration date, nor was the license renewed within 30 days after this expiration date, the substance use disorder license for A Forever Recovery (SA0590043) is expired and is no longer valid.
