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Subject: Nursing Home State Licensure Survey Findings for SKLD Bloomfield Hills

A state nursing home licensure compliance survey was completed on March 14, 2019 at SKLD Bloomfield Hills pursuant to the Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Part 201, Section 333.20155, which requires the Department to make at least one visit to each licensed health facility or agency every three years for the purpose of survey and evaluation. Pursuant to the Michigan Public Health Code Act 368 of 1978 and Part 217, Section 333.21711 requires that a nursing home is to be licensed.

The survey identified non-compliance with the following requirements:

333.21720b: Agreement with county community mental health program. During the survey process, the facility did not have evidence of an agreement with the county community mental health authority as required by statute.

The facility contacted the local Community Mental Health Authority to request an agreement with the county as required by statute. Actual compliance will be verified at the next on-site visit.

In summary, SKLD Bloomfield Hills is in compliance with the Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Article 17 Facilities and Agencies, Part 201 General Provisions (MCL 333.20101 through 333.20211); Part 17 Nursing Homes (MCL 333.21701 through 333.21799e); and/or the Michigan Administrative Rules for Nursing Homes and Nursing Care Facilities (R 325.20101 through R 325.22004), as applicable.
