Subject: Nursing Home Licensure Survey Findings for Omni Continuing Care

Dear Darcy Paisley,

A virtual state nursing home licensure survey was conducted on May 12, 2021 at Omni Continuing Care, pursuant to the Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Part 201, Section 333.20155, which requires the department to make at least one visit to each licensed health facility or agency every 3 years for survey and evaluation for the purpose of licensure. These visits can include virtual surveys conducted between the department and licensee via video conferencing. Additionally, a nursing home in Michigan is required to be licensed under the Michigan Public Health Code Act 368 of 1978 Part 217, Section 333.21711.

At the time of the survey, the following non-compliance was found:

333.20173a Background Check

Not all contracted employees had fingerprint results that associated their names with Omni Continuing Care. Four individuals were identified in an audit of files. On 5/27/2021, the facility submitted appropriate documentation indicating that the identified individuals were in the fingerprint database associated with Omni Continuing Care. Actual compliance will be verified at the time of the next licensure survey.

R 325.45199 Signing of verbal and telephone orders

The facility's policy for the signing of verbal and telephone orders indicated that verbal and telephone orders were to be signed in accordance with the state's (State of Michigan) guidelines. At the time of the survey, the facility agreed to address the non-compliance by revising their policy to include standards for when verbal and/or telephones orders should be signed. This corrective action is accepted but actual compliance will be verified at the time of the next licensure survey.

In summary, Omni Continuing Care is in substantial compliance with the Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Article 17 Facilities and Agencies, Part 201 General Provisions (MCL 333.20101 through 333.20211); Part 17 Nursing Homes (MCL 333.21701 through 333.21799e); and/or the Michigan Administrative Rules for Health Facilities or Agencies (R 325.45101 through R 325.45385), as applicable.
