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Subject: Nursing Home State Licensure Survey Findings Medilodge of Gaylord

An onsite state nursing home licensure survey was conducted on January 27, 2022, at Medilodge of Gaylord pursuant to the Michigan Public Health Code, Act 368 of 1978, Part 201, Section 333.20155, which requires the department to make at least one visit to each licensed health facility or agency every 3 years for survey and evaluation for the purpose of licensure. A nursing home in Michigan is required to be licensed under the Michigan Public Health Code Act 368 of 1978 Part 217, Section 333.21711.

Findings: No items of noncompliance were identified.
